



# **Summit County: From Unemployed to Ready for Employment**

Recently I met with a young man referred to me by his Vocational counselor. He had never worked in a competitive employment situation, despite his desire to do so, however the concerns that earning any amount of money would make him ineligible for SSI benefits was in his way. He has extensive needs that are being met by his Home and Community Based waiver program. After explaining my role as Community Work Incentives Coordinator and providing he and his family with information, we began to develop and gain approval for his Benefits Planning Query. We also reviewed and discussed specific work incentives and how these can be incorporated into his goal of earning an income. After completing this process it became apparent that earned income can be of benefit and not adversely impact his social security or other benefits. He is now working on his employment goals and opportunities.
